A year prior, owners Brian and Rachael Spielmann identified a significant missing piece in the small community of Hayward, Wisconsin was a designated memory care facility. Working with both Impact Seven and Chippewa Valley Bank, this \$2.6 million dollar project received the financing it needed, through a combination of Chippewa Valley Bank lending and a \$529,165 Impact Seven loan.
